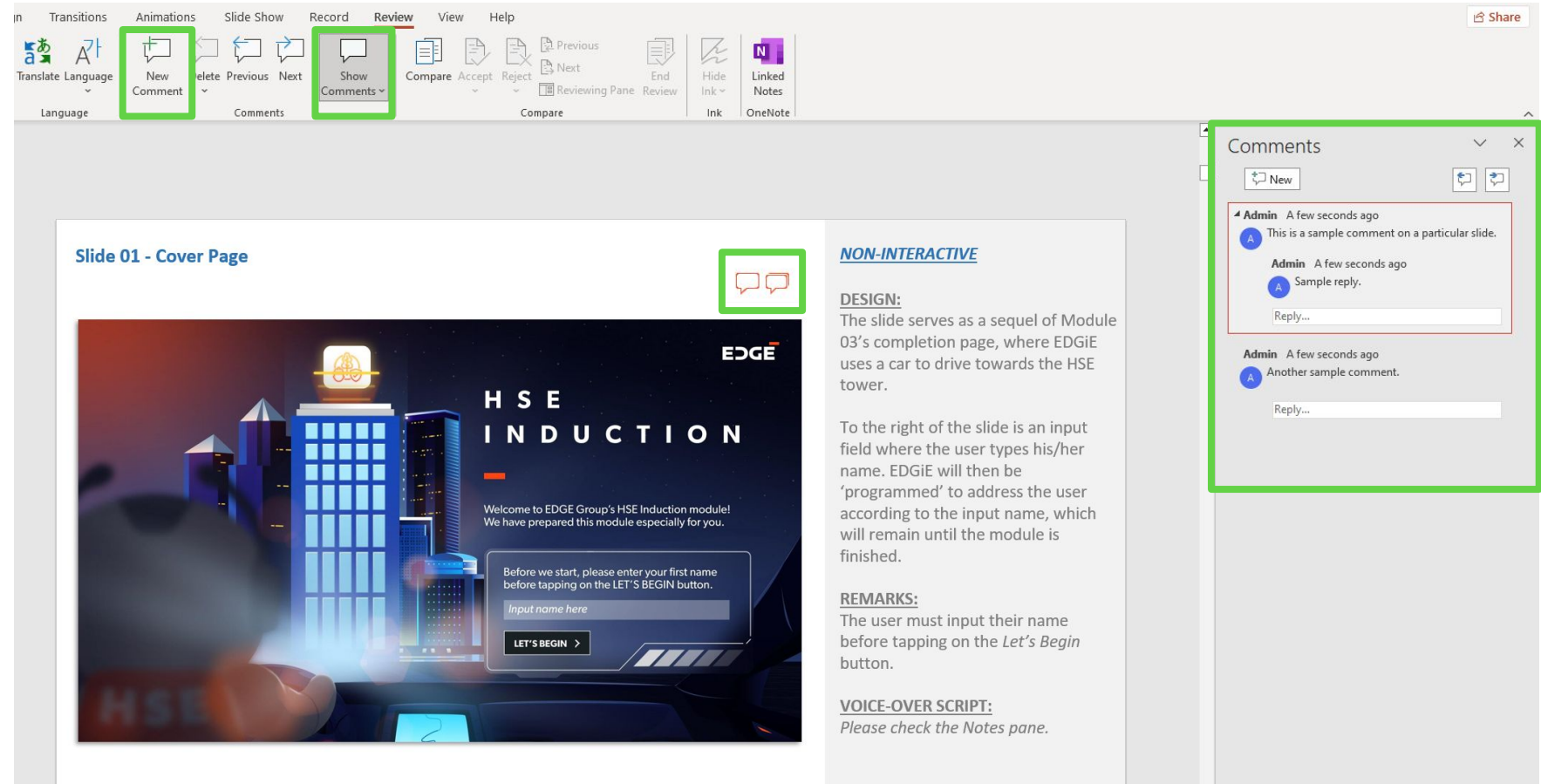

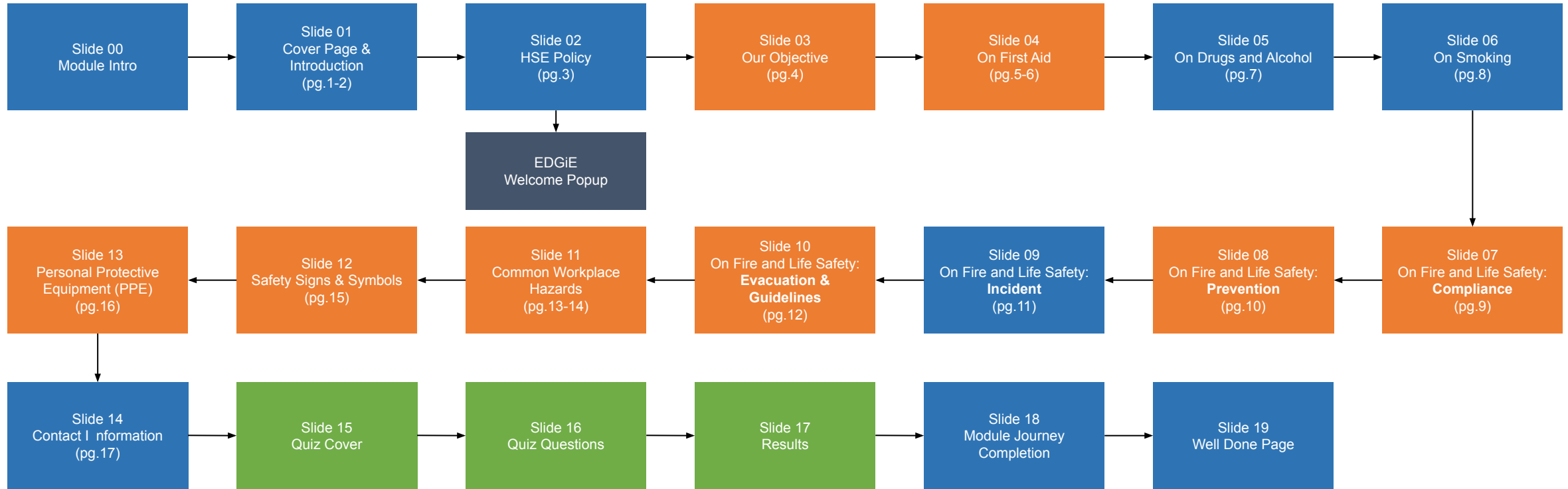
Adding Comments and Feedback

4. Type your comments, and then tap outside the comment box.



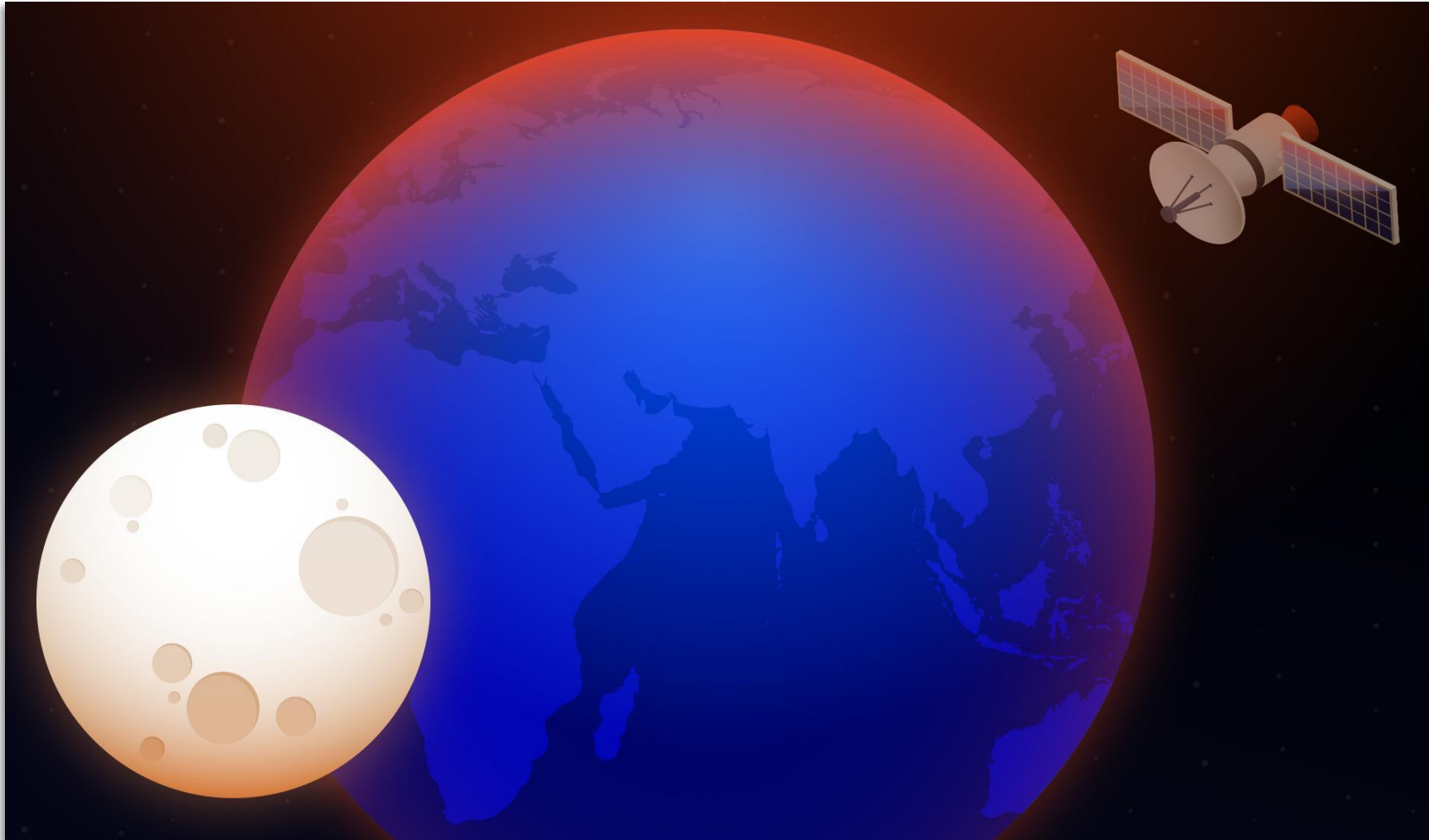

It usually involves a one-time, short-term treatment and requires little technology or training to administer.

With the Policy's goals in mind, EDGE Group complies with the Abu Dhabi Occupational Safety and Health System Code of Practice, as prescribed by the emirate's Occupational Safety and Health Centre (OSHAD).
